

Money is any object or record that is generally accepted as payment for goods and services and repayment of debts in a given socio-economic context or country. We need money when traveling to pay for all the goods we need.

Depending on the country we need different currency.

Currency is a *system* of money (monetary units) in common use, especially in a nation.^[4] Under this definition, British pounds, U.S. dollars, and European euros are different types of currency, or currencies. Currencies in this definition need not be physical objects. We can use different ways of payment during our trips.



Ways to Pay

1. **Cash.** With coins and bills.
2. **Credit or Debit Card.** We accept payment by all major credit and debit cards. Orders are dispatched immediately when using this payment method.
3. **Payment by PayPal.** We now accept payment by PayPal so you don't even have to enter your card details on our website if you have a PayPal account, providing that extra peace of mind. Orders are dispatched immediately when using this payment method.
4. **Cheque / Postal Order.** If ordering by telephone we will fax/post a Pro Forma Invoice which should be posted to The Safe Shop together with your payment by either cheque or postal order. Your order is dispatched once we receive payment.
5. **Bank Transfer.** Shortly after placing your order we will email you a Pro Forma Invoice including The Safe Shop bank details. You should use the bank details to make payment electronically via your bank. If ordering by telephone we will fax/post a Pro Forma Invoice. Your order is dispatched once we receive payment.
6. **Payment by Invoice.** 30 Day accounts are available to Local and National Government bodies, Police, NHS, Educational and Charitable organizations on receipt of a signed purchase order. 30 Day accounts are also available to business customers by providing relevant bank references.
